Purposes for which your data is processed:

The purpose of the data processing is to facilitate contact tracing of entrants, especially in case of self-monitored home quarantine being necessary.

Types of data:

The following personal data are processed:

- Personal Information (first name, surname, date of birth, citizenship, e-mail address, phone number)
- Address of residence in Austria
- Travel details (state of departure, date of next entry to Austria, means of transport, if appropriate details to means of transport, e.g. registration, flight-/ship-/train- or bus number as well as layover details of the last 10 days)
- If appropriate details of commuter traffic

If appropriate negative certificate of SARS-CoV-2 or any other medical certificate.

Legal foundation on which we process your personal data:

In the event that a medical certificate is submitted, the data processed represents health data. Even if this is not the case, in line with the view of the data protection authority, we assume that - since the data processing is carried out exclusively for public health purposes - we are processing health data. The legal basis for the data processing is therefore Art. 9 (2) lit. i DSGVO in conjunction with Section 25a EpiG and the COVID-19 Entry Ordinance.

Please note that the provision of data is required by law (§ 25a Epidemiegesetz 1950 iVm der COVID-19-EinreiseV). Failure to provide such data represents an administrative offense according to Section 40 lit. c EpiG, which is punishable by a fine of up to € 1 450.

The processing of personal data of legal representatives is based on the respective applicable material laws (ABGB for guardians, Child and Youth Welfare Acts, Adult Protection Act for adult representatives, etc).

Recipients of the data:

For data entry and collection, the form service of BRZ is used.

Our subcontractor is:

Bundesrechenzentrum GmbH, Hintere Zollamtsstraße 4, 1030 Vienna as well as their sub-processor Accenture GmbH, Börsegebäude, Schottenring 16, 1010 Vienna who is engaged with the production and operation of the form.

Accenture uses Microsoft's cloud service called Azure as a hosting service provider.

Microsoft may use other subprocessors as disclosed in the Microsoft Core Online Services Subprocessor List available here:

Accenture selected the region "EU-West" for processing and storing personal data in Azure.

However, it cannot be completely ruled out that a data transfer to the USA will take place, as Microsoft

regularly uses external service providers. Data transfers to the Microsoft Azure cloud are based on EU-Standard contractual clauses. Following the recommendations 01/2020 of the European data protection

Committee on data security measures for submission-tools to ensure an adequate level of protection of personal data under European law, all personal data is stored fully encrypted in the Azure cloud service and the key is held by the data controller within the European Union. This increased data security standard is also applied, if the form does not process any personal data of special categories (e.g. health data).

Accenture uses the services of "retarus (Austria) GesmbH" for triggering e-mail sending. All data processing of retarus (Austria) GesmbH takes place within Europe.

The data you disclose will be transmitted to the district administrative authority responsible for your place of residence and, if divergent, also to the district administrative authority responsible for your quarantine address.

The confirmation document that you receive via email or download after entering your data in the online form must be presented upon request on the occasion of an inspection upon entry, and upon request to the administrative district authority responsible for the self-monitored home quarantine. The authority checks the authenticity of the presented document by means of a QR code. The data for allowing this check is calculated from your entries in the online form. The checking body only sees the initials of your name and your year of birth.

Duration of data processing:

The data will be stored for 28 days, starting at the date of entry.

Your rights

It is an important concern of the Federal Minister for Social Affairs, Health, Care and Consumer Protection to make data processing processes understandable and transparent. Therefore, you have

the following rights to exercise within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation and the Austrian Data Protection Act as amended:

- Right of access,
- Right of rectification,
- Right to erasure,
- Right to restriction of processing,
- Right to object.

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates Austrian or European law, according to Article 77 DSGVO, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Austrian Data Protection Authority (e-mail: dsb@dsb.gv.at; Barichgasse 40-42, 1030 Vienna).
